"Tracing lipid and amino acid pathways that contribute to human disease"

Dr. Metallo will discuss how his laboratory applies stable isotope tracing and mass spectrometry-based metabolomics to understand how dysregulation of endogenous metabolic pathways drives diseases such as cancer, diabetes, and neuropathy. Specific areas of focus:

- Application of metabolic flux analysis (MFA) to quantitatively study cellular and organismal physiology
- Modulation of tumor growth and neuropathy phenotypes by diet and pharmacological interventions
- Role of enzyme promiscuity in metabolism and disease
